

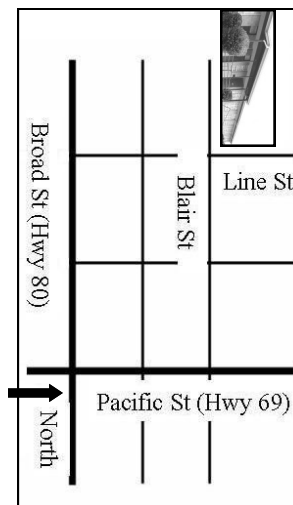
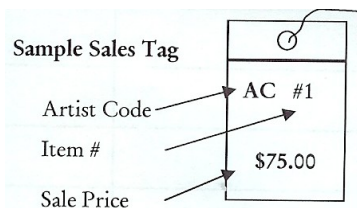
JUDY PRITCHETT-ART FESTIVAL JUDGE

She received her MFA from Cranbrook Academy of Art, Bloomfield Hills, MI, and BFA from Kansas City Art Institute, Kansas City, MO. She has participated in numerous workshops with nationally known artists, has been accepted into numerous group and solo art exhibitions, and has judged several art competitions.

- Make a Control Sheet list of all items on a Sale Room Sheet (obtain from office or from web) or on notebook paper. Include: Your Item #; Description; Sale Price; Amt. to be donated to MLOTA; & your Name on sheet.
- Present list to Sale Room when items are delivered.
- Tag each item with: Artist Initial (Artist Code); Item #; & Sale Price.

ART WORK DELIVERY: April 14, 2010

Art work will be received Wednesday, April 14, from 9:00-11:00am at the League building unless prior arrangements have been made for early delivery.

Junior Division deliveries will **also** be accepted from 4:00-6:00pm.

ALL ENTRIES MUST REMAIN ON DISPLAY FOR THE ENTIRE SHOW.

RECEPTION & AWARDS: April 15, 2010

Reception will be Thursday, April 15, from 7:00pm-8:30pm for all participants, League members and invited guests.

Special awards will be presented at 7:30pm.

SHOW EXHIBITION HOURS:

Friday, April 16, 10:00am—5:30pm

Saturday, April 17, 10:00am—5:00pm

PICK UP: April 17, 2010

All artwork will be picked up on Saturday, April 17, from 5:00-6:00pm unless prior arrangements have been made.

SALES: All show entries should be priced or marked NFS (not for sale) on entry form. A 20% donation will go to MLOTA and should be included in sale price. Tax will be added by MLOTA. Sale Room items will be the same.

SALES TAX: MLOTA will charge, collect and report Sales Tax of 8.25% on all sales. **Sales on Friday, April 16, 2010, will be tax free.**

ADULT ARTIST GUIDELINES

- ◆ Entries must be original works of art by the artist—no prints, giclee, serigraphs, lithographs, or secondary reproductions will be accepted.
- ◆ ALL art work must be original in concept, design and execution. Copies from personal pictures of the artist or hired by the artist is accepted. Copies of other art work or published photography from calendars, magazines, copy-righted material, etc., should be entered under Reproductions.
- ◆ No class work created in ANY part by the instructor or class paint-along will be accepted in the Adult Divisions.
- ◆ Artist should indicate if sculpture is unique or one of a multiple edition.
- ◆ No craft-type painting or sculpture, photography, print or other art form not deemed Fine Art will be accepted.
- ◆ Nude paintings and sculpture WILL be accepted but PLEASE only in good taste.
- ◆ Show Committee may reject any work deemed inappropriate for public viewing—gruesome, vulgar, or not meeting show guidelines.
- ◆ Artwork must have been executed since 2005 and not previously entered in this show.
- ◆ Artwork must be framed or wrap-around, wired suitable for the weight and size of the piece, dry and ready to hang. (NO saw tooth hangers will be accepted.)
- ◆ No piece should be larger than 50"x50" or 2500 sq. inches. Plexiglas is not required but PLEASE consider weight of large pieces. Pieces deemed too heavy to hang safely on screens may be rejected.
- ◆ Artist name must be taped on back/bottom of each piece.

ENTRY FEES: \$6.00 Each

Limit: 6 Paintings and/or 6 Sculptures

DIVISIONS:

Professional: Sells and/or teaches regularly.

Advanced: Painted for several years, progressed past beginner and does not sell or teach regularly.

Amateur: Beginner in art. Has not entered art shows more than 3 years.

Junior: Level 1: Ages 7-11
Level 2: Ages 12-18 (high school)

CATEGORIES:

PAINTINGS:

UNDER GLASS: Any work mounted with glass. May be watercolor, acrylic as watercolor, oil on paper, pastel, graphite, colored pencil, pen & ink, mixed media or collage.

NOT UNDER GLASS: Any work mounted open with no glass. May be oil, acrylic or any other media.

REPRODUCTIONS: Any work deemed a copy. All divisions will be judged together. Ribbons will be awarded but works will not be eligible for top awards.

SCULPTURE: All forms of relief or free standing 3-dimensional sculpture (clay, wood, stone or metal) will be accepted this first year as long as it is not of a craft nature. Large pieces must be approved prior to entering and artist must provide any "special" needed display apparatus.

AWARDS: (May be Cash, Gift Certificate or Prize)

BEST OF SHOW: \$100.00

BEST of Professional, Advanced, & Amateur: \$75.00 each.

BEST of Sculpture: \$50.00

1st. 2nd. 3rd. 4th place and Honorable Mentions in each category; Junior I & Junior II: Ribbons

People's Choice: Ribbon, Gift

Mayor's Choice: Ribbon, Gift
