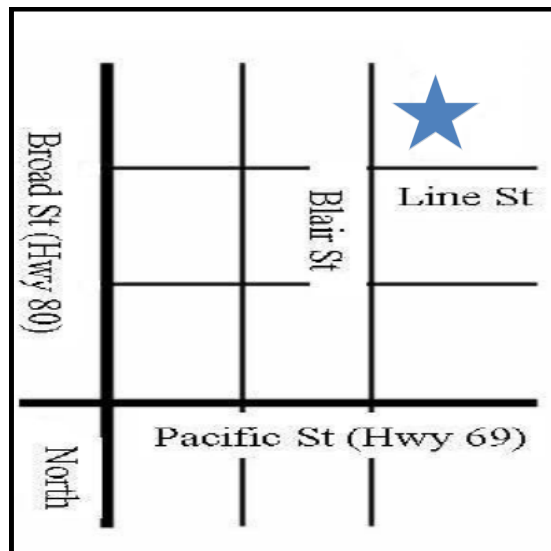

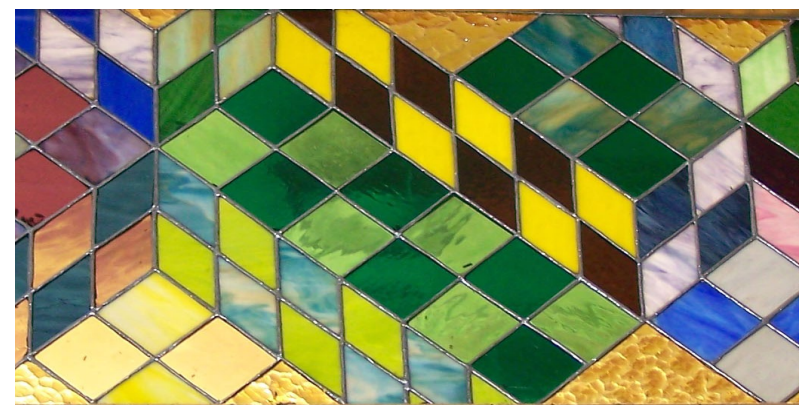

Appointments will be made for all art work to be picked up.

SALE PRICE:

All show entries should be priced or marked NFS (not for sale) on entry form. A 20% donation will go to MLOTA and should be included in sale price.

ARTIST GUIDELINES

- Show is open to all fine art painters, sculptors, and photographers. You do NOT have to be a member of MLOTA to enter.
- ALL show art work must be original in concept, design and execution, except reproductions. JUNIOR 1 & 2 which may be classroom work.
- Entries must be original works of art by the artists. No prints of paintings or drawings, giclee, serigraphs, lithographs, or secondary reproductions will be accepted.
- Work created in ANY part by the instructor, class paint-along, or work copied from instructional materials will not be accepted in the Adult Divisions.
- **Copies of other art work or published photography, from calendars, magazines, copy-righted material, Pinterest, or other internet sources, or professional photographers (other than yourself) etc., should be entered under REPRODUCTIONS by adults.**
- No craft-type painting, sculpture, printed art work, or computer generated art will be accepted.
- Nude paintings and sculpture WILL be accepted but PLEASE only in good taste.
- Show Committee may reject any work deemed inappropriate for public viewing, gruesome, violent, vulgar, unsightly, or not meeting show guidelines.
- Artwork must be framed or gallery wrapped, wired suitable for weight and size of piece, dry and ready to hang. NO saw tooth hangers will be accepted.
- Junior non-canvas work must be at least matted and able to hang.
- No pieces larger than 50x50 or 2500 sq. inch. Plexiglas is not required but PLEASE consider weight and MUST be able to hang on screens.
- Artist name MUST be on back of painting.
- All entries MUST have been completed within last 3 years.

DIVISIONS

Professional: Sells and/or teaches regularly, or artist deems skill level appropriate.

Advanced: Painted several years, progressed past intermediate and does not sell or teach regularly.

Intermediate: Painted more than 2 and less than 5 yrs.

Beginner: Just started in art or painted 2 yr. or less.

Junior 1: Ages 6-12

Junior 2: Ages 13-18 (high school)

ADULT CATEGORIES

1. OIL
2. WATERCOLOR
3. ACRYLIC
4. PASTEL : Colored Pencil
5. DRAWING: Pen/Ink, Graphite, Charcoal
6. OTHER: Collage, Mixed Media, Encaustic, Alcohol Ink, anything else
7. ABSTRACT: Contemporary, all mediums
8. REPRODUCTION - Work not from the artist original concept **

SCULPTURE/2D OR 3D: Large pieces require approval and display apparatus. No craft will be allowed.

PHOTOGRAPHY – 8x10 matted and framed in an 11x14 frame **

**Reproductions and Photography are not eligible for Best of Division or Best of Show award.

Final Decision on categories at the discretion of the Show Committee – if there are a small number of entries in categories, the Judge or Show Committee may combine categories.
